## Vineland Estates Winery and Niagara Falls Tour and Dinner

Your tour of this property, which dates back to 1845 and was originally a Mennonite homestead, will include the vineyard, grape presses, the cellars and the production area followed by a wine tasting in the 1877 Balcony featuring three award winning premium wines.

Following the winery tour, the trip will continue through the Niagara area with detailed commentary outlining the historical, cultural, and geographical highlights of the region. At Niagara Falls, you will be able to stand at the very edge of the spectacular Falls. Afterwards, browse through the gift shops or simply just enjoy the view. Watch the lights come on and experience the beauty of the Falls at night while enjoying a three course dinner at a restaurant overlooking the Falls.
