ELIGIBILITY: A candidate must have a M.D. or D.O. degree, and must be board-certified or board-eligible in Radiology by either the American Board of Radiology or the Canadian equivalent. A candidate must have completed a residency in diagnostic Radiology. Awardees are expected to hold a position as either an Assistant Professor of Radiology, or as a Neuroradiology fellow (with or without an academic title, such as lecturer or instructor). Junior faculty are encouraged to participate.

While under the auspices of the NER Research Awards, the candidate must be in an approved fellowship program, or be serving as a faculty member in an approved Neuroradiology program. The candidate must be under the direct supervision of an ASNR *Senior* Member, who is willing to act as mentor and project supervisor.
