- ◆ Women in Neuroradiology Leadership Award

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES

PURPOSE

The Foundation of the American Society of Neuroradiology (Foundation), American College of Radiology (ACR), and American Association for Women Radiologists (AAWR) have established an award to provide leadership opportunities for women in Neuroradiology. Since Neuroradiologists must be leaders in the field, this award is for mid-career women with demonstrated experience and promise for leadership in Neuroradiology and/or Radiology overall. The objectives are to provide the awardee with additional skills and insights to enhance opportunities for advancement. The ACR Radiology Leadership Institute is launching their premier leadership educational event in conjunction with Northwestern's Kellogg School of Management July 12-15 of 2012. The winner of the joint ASNR/ACR/AAWR award will receive tuition and transportation to attend this inaugural event.

ELIGIBILITY

A candidate must have a MD or DO degree and CAQ in Neuroradiology. Candidates must have demonstrated experience and promise for leadership in radiology. Applicant must have become a member of ASNR, ACR, and AAWR prior to January 1 of the year applying for the award. Strong consideration will be given to applicants from practices and institutions that show a commitment to the applicant's career development.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

All applications should include (these documents are to be e-mailed):

- A. An application form
- B. A current curriculum vitae
- C. A statement from the applicant that describes the applicants' involvement within the ASNR, ACR, and/or AAWR (e.g. committee member, prior award recipient, etc.), qualifications, professional aspirations, and goals for attending the Academy.
- D. Two letters of support from academic chair or practice leader and from a leader outside of the applicant's department or practice but relevant to leadership area of interest.

CONDITION OF APPOINTMENT

- A. Funds will go directly to the applicant for travel costs only. The Radiology Leadership Institute fees will be waived. All other expenditures will be at the expense of the applicant.
- B. Within six (6) months of attending the Academy, awardee must submit a brief written summary detailing how attending the Leadership Academy assisted in your professional development, insights gained, etc. *Summaries may be published on the Foundation's website/newsletter.*

ALLOWANCES

The successful applicant will be provided with meeting registration fee and travel expenses only. All other expenditures will be at the expense of the applicant.

METHOD OF NOMINATION

- A. Award will be designated and administered by The Foundation of the American Society of Neuroradiology.
- B. The Review Committee will provide review and recommendations to the Foundation/ACR/AAWR for the award.
- C. Award will be announced at the annual Meeting of the ASNR.

AWARD SCHEDULE

- A. The deadline for receipt of Applications and required attachments is 9:00 AM Central Daylight Time, Monday, January 9, 2012; late applications will not be accepted. These should be submitted electronically (in .pdf or .doc format) to Stephanie Walsh (swalsh@asnr.org). On the subject line of e-mail submissions, indicate Women in Neuroradiology Leadership Award. Applications will only be accepted electronically; no hard copy documents by mail or fax will be accepted.
- B. Selection of award recipients will be in early 2012, with subsequent notification of the recipient. All those with interests in the award, or employees of an institution that may be involved in the award, shall recuse themselves from voting on such applications.
- C. Announcement of the award will be made on the ASNR website and at the next Annual Meeting.
