Duration (a range of durations in acceptable):	In the ideal situation we would like one professor to be in Bangkok for 4 weeks, split into two periods of two weeks each, in any months of the year. The dates are open so that the visiting professor will have full flexibility to choose any consecutive 2 weeks in each month. The months are also flexible; if the proposed timing does not fit the visitor's convenience we can adjust the timing accordingly. If two visits of two weeks each are not possible, we would consider a single visit of two weeks, or possibly 2 professors in 2019, one for 2 weeks in the first half of the year, and a second different person in the second half of the year. The professor would be in Ramathibodi, Siriraj or Chulalongkorn University Hospitals, Bangkok, or alternately in Chiangmai, Khonkaen or Hat Yai.
The Host Organization will provide (describe what expenses and resources will be covered by the host organization):	The host organization will provide local housing, meals and local transportation.
Activities expected of the Professor:	

The ASNR professor will be expected to give traditional lectures, as well as perform case reviews and teaching-file reviews, and participate in direct teacher-to-student “view-box”/ “workstation” teaching. The professor each week will give approximately three to four didactic lectures, and spend approximately four half-days in direct teaching sessions, with one full day and the remaining half days free for activities of their own choosing. The professor is encouraged to bring their own case-based board-review type teaching presentations also. The professor may also be asked to speak at a local or regional Continuing Education event. There is some flexibility in the scope of type of these activities which can be discussed with the liaison person for the Host Organization and/or the liaison person for the ASNR. Neuroradiology work at the hospital is mostly CTs and MRIs, with 2 MRIs (3T and 1.5T) and 2 CTs (1 of them is 320-slice scanner) for education and service, sharing with body imaging section. There are 6 full-time neuroradiology attending doctors from the radiology department, one full-time neuroradiology attending from the Advanced Imaging Center (AIMC), and 8 fellows in the 2017-2018 educational year.

Activities expected of the Professor:	The professor will give between 3 and 5 lectures at a national Continuing Medical Education event during the 2-week professorship. Apart from lectures at the conference, the professor will be expected to teach smaller groups, through a mixture of traditional lectures, perform case reviews, teaching-file reviews, and participate in direct teacher-to-student “view-box”/“workstation” teaching. During each week he/she will give an average of 4-6 lectures and spend a sum total of approximately 20-25 hours in direct teaching sessions. A diagnostic imaging specialist medical translator fluent in English and Ukrainian will be available for the conference. A portion of the conference will be broadcast live as a webinar. Well-equipped, modern lecture halls with LCD projectors will be available. For hands on apprentice-ship style teaching, state of the art MRI and CT scanners and PACS are available.
