I, Dr Klenam Dzefi-Tettey, the Head of the radiology department of the Korle Bu Teaching hospital, Accra; Ghana and my staff were honored to receive Prof Majid Khan as the Anne G. Osborn ASNR International Outreach visiting Professor from 21st to 26th May 2023.

Majid Khan is an Associate Professor of Radiology, Otolaryngology and Neurosurgery. He is also the Director, Non-Vascular Spine Intervention; Russell H. Morgan Department of Radiology and Radiological Science. Our reports have also been modified example is that i have included the Spine Instability Neoplastic Score (SINS) he mentioned during one of his lectures in our template and even pasted it in the reading room of our work stations.


The overall feedback from residents and colleagues is great and his departure was very difficult for us. Most residents have developed interest in neuroradiology.
